### **Position Summary:**

Supervise agricultural operations for Wyoming Sugar Company to ensure optimal acreage and production of high-quality sugar beets to be utilized in the production of sugar. Assist in the supervision of maintaining and operating receiving stations and equipment in the most efficient manner. Monitor sugar beet storage piles for minimal loss and maximum sugar recovery when processed. Be directly involved in monitoring and advising growers regarding agronomic practices for high quality sugar beet production. This position will also act as a liaison between sugar beet growers and Wyoming Sugar Company.

### **Primary Functions and Responsibilities:**

- Assist with the completion of contract addendums, and review Map It Fast (GPS mapping) fields with growers
- Have strong communication skills to advise growers regarding agronomic practices to assure the factory operation of the highest quality raw product
- Assure crop quality by communicating with growers through timely visits
- Maintain detailed, accurate records and report weekly, monthly, and annually on crop progress
- Maintain detailed, accurate records for each grower
- Collaborate with growers, University personnel, seed company representatives, and researchers regarding sugar beet agronomic research, seed improvements and a variety of cutting-edge research to assure a high-quality product
- Maintain an accurate log of growing conditions and environmental influences on crop development throughout the production area
- Assist with supervision of the harvest crews and receiving operation of sugar beets from the growers to assure quality will be maintained during storage
- Be responsible for sugar beet storage piles and monitor re-haul operations of sugar beet storage to help minimize waste and storage losses

### **Skills and Education:**

- Bachelor's Degree in Agriculture-related study, equivalent on the job training, or a combination of education and job experience in an agriculture-related field
- Good organizational and multi-tasking skills
- General agriculture equipment knowledge
- Proficient with current technology and experience with Excel, Word and similar programs
- Possess current Driver's License and have good driving record
- Knowledge of data collecting practices and documentation
